The National Dog Training Award Scheme Foundation Obedience Training Award


| | Skill Description | ✓ |
|----|---|---|
| 1 | Dog can be positioned in a sit position by the handlers' side on lead whilst stationary. | |
| 2 | Dog can be positioned in a down position by the handlers' side on lead whilst stationary. | |
| 3 | Dog can be positioned in a stand position by the handlers' side on lead whilst stationary. | |
| 4 | Handler can gently towel dry their dog. Dog can be in any position and remains relaxed. | |
| 5 | Handler can demonstrate the controlled removal and refitting of dogs' collar, lead and/or harness. | |
| 6 | The handler can give an article/toy to the dog, but then take it away when instructed. The dog should readily give up the article. | |
| 7 | Dog should take a treat without snatching and in a controlled manner. | |
| 8 | Recall with dog on lead, held by an assistant, in any position whilst the handler moves 2-3 paces forward, turns and calls the dog. | |
| 9 | Handler carries with them some form of "poop scoop" and identifies suitable disposal points. | |
| 10 | Dog remains calm and relaxed whilst someone checks the dog's micro-chip number using a scanner. | |

Bronze Obedience Training Award


| | Skill Description |  |
|----|---|---|
| 1 | Dog on lead without distractions the handler and dog should walk approx. 15m including a turn without undue inconvenience, on a loose lead. | |
| 2 | The handler and dog can walk on lead and under control through a doorway or gate. | |
| 3 | Dog on lead, the handler can introduce their dog to a placid unknown dog and to an unknown adult (both male and female). | |
| 4 | Dog can be positioned in a sit and down position by the handlers' side during forward movement on lead. | |
| 5 | Dog left in the sit position to wait, whilst the handler moves forward 4m, turns and calls the dog. Can be conducted on training line or netted lane. | |
| 6 | Dog can be left in a any position on lead whilst the handler takes a step to the side, returning after 60 seconds. | |
| 7 | Dog can be left in a sit position off lead whilst the handler does a complete walking circle around dog's position 1m away, returning after 30 seconds. | |
| 8 | Dog can relax on a bed (provided by and placed beside the handler), remaining calm whilst other dogs are partaking in activities. | |
| 9 | Handler gently feels all over the dog with their hands, including checking teeth, body, paws and pads. Dog can be in any position remaining relaxed. | |
| 10 | Dog wears a collar and identity tag complying with the law. Dog remains relaxed and accepting as handler demonstrates how they groom their dog. | |

Silver Obedience Training Award

| | Skill Description |  |
|----|--|---|
| 1 | Handler can send dog to its bed from 5m away, but handler will wait stationary for 30 seconds before joining beside the dog. | |
| 2 | Handler should present food to the dog in a bowl, but dog must wait for 20 seconds to be given permission to eat. | |
| 3 | The handler can throw an article 5m away, once it lands stationary the dog will go to the article pick it up and return to handler. | |
| 4 | Dog stays in sit or down position off lead whilst the handler takes two steps (1m) away, returning when instructed after 2 minutes. | |
| 5 | The handler can take the dog on lead to a group of people and dogs, remove lead and leave dog. Then walk away calling the dog to them. | |
| 6 | Off lead the dog left in the sit position to wait, whilst the handler moves forward 4m, turns and calls the dog to sit in front of them. | |
| 7 | Dog can demonstrate the finish exercise as a standalone exercise. | |
| 8 | The handler can get the dog in and out of a vehicle in a controlled manner. Dog remaining calm and relaxed. | |
| 9 | Handler and dog can walk on lead under control on a public highway (on pavement), including change of direction and stopping at a kerb to cross a road safely. | |
| 10 | Dog remains relaxed whilst a unknown adult checks their teeth and gently feels all over the dogs' body. | |

Gold Obedience Training Award

| | Skill Description | ✓ |
|----|--|---|
| 1 | Dog stays in sit or down position off lead whilst the handler moves 2m away in front of dog, returning when instructed after 2 minutes. | |
| 2 | Off lead dog is left in the sit or down position and is then called through a controlled group of people and dogs to handler's front, then finish. | |
| 3 | Handler can leave dog on its bed, with an unknown adult holding lead, whilst handler goes 10m away out of sight for 3 minutes, dog remains on bed relaxed. | |
| 4 | Dog waits off lead in stand position, the handler does a complete circle around dog 1m away, then calls the dog to heel and continues forward 6 paces. | |
| 5 | The handler can throw a dumbbell or training dummy 10m away, once it lands stationary the dog will go and pick it up, return item to handler and finish. | |
| 6 | The handler can face the dog from 6m away, call the dog towards them and stop dog on command. Dog stopping at least 3m away. | |
| 7 | Dog on lead, the handler should walk the dog close to food left on the ground at a less than 1m distance. The dog must leave the food. | |
| 8 | Dog on lead can walk 50m, to include left, right and about turn, at slow, normal and fast pace variations on instruction. At all times dog in a "heel" position. | |
| 9 | Dog off lead can walk 25m, to include left, right and about turn, at all times dog in a "heel" position. | |
| 10 | The handler can place dogs article away amongst three other non-similar "clean" articles, the dog will go to their article pick it up and return to the handler. | |





The National Dog Training Award Scheme Platinum Obedience Training Award


| | Skill Description |  |
|----|---|---|
| 1 | Dog off lead can walk 50m, to include left, right and about turn, at slow, normal and fast pace variations on instruction. At all times dog by handlers side . | |
| 2 | Dog from any position, recalled to heel by handler, on command of assessor, whilst handler is walking away from dog, both to continue forward until ordered to halt. | |
| 3 | Dog left in the sit or down position and then called through and between two bowls with food 3m apart, to handler's front, then finish. Dog must not eat food. | |
| 4 | Handler will send the dog to a marked area, no bed. After the dog has been dropped to down position, the handler will collect the dog. | |
| 5 | Handler standing other side of a dummy road (5m wide) dog is called from 6m behind kerb the other side. Dog is stopped before kerb on command. | |
| 6 | The handler can throw a dumbbell or training dummy 5m away over hurdle, dog will retrieve over hurdle (both directions), return to handler. | |
| 7 | The handler can place dogs scent cloth with handlers scent amongst three similar "clean" cloths, the dog will go to their cloth pick it up and return to the handler. | |
| 8 | Dog stays in stand position off lead whilst the handler moves 2m away in front of dog, returning when instructed after 1 minute. | |
| 9 | Dog stays in sit position off lead whilst the handler moves 2m away in front of dog, returning when instructed after 3 minutes. | |
| 10 | Dog stays off lead whilst the handler moves out of sight, returning when instructed after 2 minutes. Change of position acceptable. | |

Diamond Obedience Training Award

| | Skill Description |  |
|----|--|---|
| 1 | Dog off lead can walk 50m, to include left, right and about turns, at slow, normal and fast paces on instruction. At all times dog in a “heel” position. | |
| 2 | Dog left in sit, handler walks away in pattern directed by assessor, including turns, dog called to heel when instructed, both continue forward off lead as instructed. | |
| 3 | Handler will send the dog to a marked area, no bed. After the dog has been dropped to down position, the handler will recall the dog to front, then finish. | |
| 4 | Dog left in sit position in marked area. Handler leaves dog, turns and faces 5m away. Handler drops the dog to down and then back to sit position. Collects dog. | |
| 5 | Throwing an article or by someone calling dog 10m away from handler, the handler must stop the dog in any position, and collect dog, 5m before person/article. | |
| 6 | The handler can throw a dumbbell or training dummy 10m away over hurdle, dog will retrieve over hurdle (both directions), return to handler and finish. | |
| 7 | The handler can place dogs scent cloth with handlers scent amongst six identical “ decoy scented ” cloths, the dog will return their cloth to front, then finish. | |
| 8 | Dog stays in stand position off lead whilst the handler moves 2m away in front of dog, returning when instructed after 2 minutes. | |
| 9 | Dog stays in sit position off lead whilst the handler moves 4m away in front of dog, returning when instructed after 3 minutes. | |
| 10 | Dog stays in down position off lead whilst the handler moves out of sight, returning when instructed after 3 minutes. No change of position acceptable. | |
